Includes the researcher's salary (assistant professorship level), a research grant, salaries of employees as well as a contribution to infrastructure costs • 4 years; may be extended by no more than 2 years • Call: 1 May 2017 <p>International Short Visits</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For researchers in Switzerland who wish to go abroad for a short period or researchers abroad who wish to collaborate with researchers in Switzerland. During the visit, they pursue a small joint research project • From 1 week to 3 months. • Calls all year round
