Admission criteria and application procedure

The Graduate Institute nominates incoming exchange graduate non degree student(s) to the International Programs Office at AUC

Once you receive your confirmation of nomination, fill the AUC graduate application form [here](#)

Supporting documents include:

- Graduate AY application (select non-degree program)
- The application fee is waived
- Personal statement
- Copies of transcripts for all colleges attended
- Official final Bachelor's degree transcript with proof of degree completion
- Copy of the most recent transcript of the current graduate program
- One recommendation letter and the nomination letter from the school
- A list of courses (with course code included) in which the students wishes to register (five courses at least)
- Student Resume
- Valid International TOEFL scores or academic IELTS exam (required from applicants applying from non-English language universities. TOEFL or IELTS are not needed if the student can provide proof that s/he completed at least one year of academic study at an accredited university during which English was the sole language of instruction). NB. The Institute's MA year will not be considered as teaching is carried out in 2 language and this even if the student took all classes through English.
- Passport copy
- 2 passport size photographs
- Physical form and HIV test results (post acceptance)
All students are required to submit the results of a full physical examination to AUC. This information should be sent to AUC's New York Office prior to departing for Egypt. Students also need to submit the results of an HIV Antibodies Test taken within 30 days of their departure for Egypt. This is an Egyptian Government

*GMAT or GRE scores are waived for graduate exchange students.
