Courses open to exchange students

Most Elliott School courses numbered 6000 and above except capstone and cornerstones, which are for degree students only. Exchange students are also eligible to take most courses numbered 6000 and above in any other school or department except those in the School of Medicine and Health Sciences, the Law School, and certain courses that are restricted to degree candidates or any specific prerequisites.
