Additional information concerning housing, monthly living expenses

Dormitory like accommodation is provided on campus. The fee is RM15/day for twin sharing and without meals. There are also apartment/condominium around the campus for students to rent. The rental fees range from RM1800 - RM2500 depending on the size of the apartment/condominium. A fee for student services is charged to exchange students (approx.. 100CHF).
