<b>Places available for 2019-2020</b>	2
<b>Open to</b>	MA and PhD students
<b>Courses open to exchange students</b>	All except Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences and Department of Accounting. Approval for any study area is dependent on academic background and acceptance by department
<b>Language/s of instruction</b>	Courses are offered in English, Afrikaans or the T-option (a combination of English and Afrikaans in the same class with notes available in English). The language of instruction will be indicated in relevant department's website and the yearbook of the relevant faculty. Students should take note of the language of instruction when choosing courses.
<b>Language requirements</b>	No language certificate required
<b>Academic Calendar</b>	First semester: January to June Second semester: July-December.

- Copies of identification pages of your passport (Your passport should be valid for the time indicated by the SA Mission after leaving South Africa.)
