Approximate Living Expenses for 2013-14 (two terms - 8 months) for a Single Student*

Rent/Utilities/Food	12,460
Books & Supplies	1,100
Medical (insurance etc.)	1,914
Personal Expenses (clothing/laundry, recreation/entertainment, local transportation, miscellaneous)	3,456
Total Living Expenses	\$18,930

*Because students will be at the University of Michigan Law School for ONE term (four months), they must certify funds in the minimum amount of \$9,465, which is half of \$18,930.
