

# **JAPANESE CHAPTER OF THE ALUMNI OF THE IHEID**

## **Statute**

### **I. Foundation of the Japanese Chapter**

The Japanese Chapter of the Association of the Alumni (l'Association des Anciens, AAI) of the Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies (l'Institut de hautes études internationales et du développement, IHEID; hereinafter the "Institute") is created, in accordance with Article 11 of the Statute of the AAI (2006) concerning the creation of national chapters of the AAI.

### **II. Purposes**

The Japanese Chapter of the AAI has the following purposes:

1. To strengthen ties between the Institute and the alumni residing in Japan;
2. To strengthen ties between the alumni residing in Japan themselves;
3. To promote the Institute and its activities;
4. To assist those who wish to study at the Institute.

### **III. Membership**

1. Any person, who studied at the Institute (or, formerly, at the Graduate Institute of International Studies, IUHEI or the Graduate Institute of Development Studies, IUED) for at least one semester and lives in Japan at the time of his or her application for membership, can be a member of the Japanese Chapter of the AAI, by a simple declaration of his or her wish to become a member.

2. No membership fee is required.

### **IV. Annual Assembly**


The Annual Assembly of the Japanese Chapter of the AAI is held once a year. It elects members of the steering committee of the Japanese Chapter who organize the meetings of the Annual Assembly and other annual programs.

### **V. Partnership**

The Japanese Chapter shall plan and conduct its activities with close contact and cooperation with the AAI.
