

# LEADERSHIP SKILLS TRAINING COURSE YEREVAN 5–7 OCTOBER 2010

The Swiss Cooperation Office and the Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies in Geneva are pleased to organise a three days seminar on Leadership.

## OBJECTIVES

- Present essential concepts and frameworks for enhancing the participants' leadership skills in their various areas of expertise and influence
- Build on the own strengths through developing and exploring the own leadership style
- Acquire leadership tools that enable to respond to the demands of different situations from the national to the global

## TARGET AUDIENCE

The training is designed for senior officials from the government of the Republic of Armenia. Participants will have a unique opportunity to develop their leadership skills and respond to both individual career needs and the ever-increasing demand for management professionals.

## PROGRAMME AND METHODOLOGY

The 3-days full-time programme is built around 3 modules:

### Module 1

#### Leadership tools

- Power and influence, personality, motivation, teams
- Key leadership skill: Communication
- Key leadership skill: Negotiation

### Module 2

#### Leading an organisation

- Setting goals, creating buy-in, reaching targets
- Organisational culture
- Managing processes

### Module 3

#### Leadership for governance

- My leadership style: legacy
- Leadership values, goals, ethics
- Bringing about change: from the national to the global

The course will be taught in English. The combination of presentations, practical exercises and videos will stimulate the participants to undergo intensive self-reflection. The trainers will teach skills that can be applied to numerous circumstances, each time adapting to the needs of the leader's environment.
