

French Test

A French test will be organised in the beginning of the academic year to validate students' knowledge of the French language. A pass/fail result will be reported on the student's transcript. Students who do not successfully pass the test at the beginning of their studies will have another opportunity to take the test again during their second year. While the result will appear on the transcript, failing the French test will not affect the successful completion of the student's study programme.

Students will not be required to take the French test if they:

- are of French mother tongue
- have completed secondary education in French attested by the diploma
- have completed at least one year of university studies through French attested by the transcript
- submit a French language certificate equivalent to a DELF B2 level
