Candidates must hold – or be expected to hold – a Ph.D. in Economics or equivalent from a leading university. They should have a strong analytical background and broad interests in international macroeconomics. They must demonstrate interest in at least one of the following subfields: 1) macroeconomic policies including international issues; 2) links between financial markets and international macroeconomics; 3) econometric applications to macroeconomics (macroeconometrics) including international issues.

The chosen candidate will teach international macroeconomics and its applications in all three of the Institute's programs (Master in International Affairs, Master and Ph.D. in International Economics). They will also supervise master and doctoral theses.

The language of instruction is either English or French, but candidates will be expected to soon acquire, if not already possess, a working knowledge of the other language.
