CAREER-FUNDING INSTRUMENTS FOR PHD STUDENTS

<p>SNSF</p>	<p>Doc.CH</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For promising researchers who wish to write a doctoral thesis in the humanities and social sciences in Switzerland • From 2 to 4 years • Calls twice a year: 10 March and 10 September <p>Doc.Mobility</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For doctoral students who wish to enhance their scientific profile by doing research at an institution abroad • From 6 to 18 months • Calls twice a year: 1 March and 1 September <p>Marie Heim Voegtlin (MHV)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For female doctoral students and postdocs in Switzerland who had to interrupt or reduce their research activities due to family commitments • Up to 2 years • Possibility to work part-time • One call per year: August
<p>Swissuniversities (CRUS)</p>	<p>Study Abroad Scholarships</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On behalf of the Swiss government, swissuniversities manages scholarships from over 30 foreign governments which are available to Swiss students and/or researchers interested in studying abroad • Check deadline on the site
