| Swiss Government (SERI) | <p>Swiss Government Excellence Scholarships</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The research scholarship is available to postgraduate researchers in any discipline (who hold a master's degree as a minimum) who are planning to come to Switzerland to pursue research or further studies at doctoral or postdoctoral level • Only candidates nominated by an academic mentor at a Swiss higher education institution (cantonal university, university of applied sciences, federal institute of technology) will be considered • Calls: check deadline on the site – Graduate Institute's procedure also to be followed | | |
