

ECONOMIC FREEDOM AND POLITICAL RIGHTS:

Neoliberal Challenges to Democracy

ext year, 2023, will mark fifty years of the bloody US-supported coup d'état in Chile that overthrew the democratically elected government of Salvador Allende and installed a brutal military dictatorship under General Augusto Pinochet. The Pinochet regime's logic of 'usurping' and 'economizing' the democratic has been enacted in the decades since in many countries, including Western democracies. Subordinating political rights to economic freedom and identifying democratic legitimacy with passive consent, some of them have also responded to movements like Black Lives Matter and Extinction Rebellion with laws and regulations virtually outlawing public protests.

This international workshop is a collaborative effort to map the genealogies and trajectories of neoliberal governance between dictatorship and democracy. It will be a prelude to talks, workshops, conferences, and other events over the next 18 months to help place in perspective the profound implications of the 1973 coup and the dictatorship for our rights, freedoms, and democratic aspirations, both in Chile as well as in the wider world.
